No update on this section, however, SCC have been working on clearing and repairing the riverbank footpath section between Judes Ferry and King's Staunch.c. SCC Development – No update.d. Building site at the entrance to Pott Hall Road – Cllr A Fisher has spoken to WSC regarding the site and awaiting a response.e. New Cemetery – We are still awaiting the sales contract from SCC's legal department; however, Cllr M Peachey has chased up and has been informed that this is being dealt with. In the meantime, SCC have given written permission for us to proceed with the Archaeological survey on the site so as not to hold anything up. This is still expected, weather permitting, in early January. From our point of view, the best-case scenario is that they don't find anything, meaning that no further investigation would be necessary. The landscaping plans have been drawn up, which we need to get approved by WSC. Cllr M Peachey did request a few changes to the plans, and is waiting on these to come back, before submitting them. Depending on the timeframe, it may make sense until the archaeology report is complete as well and then submit everything to WSC in one go. Overall, everything is moving along nicely, and Cllr M Peachey is content with the progress.	AF
